

Village of Elmsford Winter Storm Information Update

The Village of Elmsford remains under a Declared State of Emergency.

Village crews continue to work on opening streets to a width to provide for the safe passage of vehicles and to help insure public safety. Crews will continue to work throughout the night and tomorrow. The removal of parked cars from the street during plowing provides the plows a better opportunity to clear the streets, travel safely. This storm has deposited a very wet heavy snow making it very difficult to clear the streets without numerous passes. As such we apologize that opened driveways and walkways may become filled with snow but the snow must be removed from the street to provide adequate public safety.

Several Streets remain partially closed in the Village due to down utility lines. They include sections of North Perkins, North French, North Hillside, and Undercliff. Con Edison has been advised of these situations and are doing their best under the circumstances to take corrective action.
