Important Recycling Info

Westchester County is stepping up enforcement of its mandatory recycling law requiring all municipalities to separate the waste generated within their communities. Starting Feb. 1, 2008, recyclables that are not properly separated will not get picked up.

The Village of Elmsford closely follows the County Law and will be placing Yellow Stickers as shown below on cans that contain waste and recyclables that are not properly separated.
