## Detective Yearly Report

**(January 1st, 2021- December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2021)**

For the year of 2021 the Detective Division has handled 145 cases. These cases were investigated and handled by the Elmsford Detective Division and included the assistance of WCPD, Greenburgh PD, Westchester County District Attorney's Office, NYPD, Yonkers PD and Westchester County Real Time Crime. Of the 145 cases 9 are still open, 10 are suspended due to lack of cooperation from victims and 10 were unfounded/non-criminal. The Detective Division applied for and was granted 4 search warrants which were all carried out safely. Detective Division obtained 12 arrest warrants and entered 6 bench warrants. 10 out of the 18 warrants have been executed and processed.

## Juvenile Yearly Report

**(January 1st, 2021- December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2021)**

For the year of 2021 the Detective Division has handled 6 juvenile cases. These cases were investigated and handled by the Elmsford Detective Division and included the assistance of WCPD, Greenburgh PD, Westchester County District Attorney's Office and Child Protective Services. Although some cases are still pending with the courts there are currently no Juvenile cases open carrying into the year of 2022.

The Detective Division/Juvenile Office has been involved in the following:

- 1: Assisted all Elmsford schools with resources/input regarding juvenile matters.
- 2: Investigated and addressed multiple alleged threats/concerns found by school staff via social media.
- 3: Responded to aided cases involving students.
- 4: Presentations for career day for any students potentially interested in Law Enforcement.

## End Of Year Report

Commissioner,

2021 school year was a hard year for schools, most of the school year was conducted remotely and ended in person. Not too many events occurred in the schools as you would expect. Although, schools were closed, teachers and administrators were present. As part of my duties as an SRO, the schools were still walked daily and when needed assistance was provided.

As students returned to the schools, the volume of assistance increased. SRO was posted for every opening and closing of the schools. Walkthroughs increased but were moderated in order to prevent cross contamination of the virus between schools. Some students showed signs of emotional stress behavior and the SRO assisted in getting the proper help to every individual in need. Together with the school counselors and school psychologists, assistance was provided without the need of police escalation and response. This goes to prove that the system in place is working and necessary. Attached you will find the highlights of the events and calls I conducted this year.

During 2021 I assisted the Detective Division with a rape case and assisted patrol with controlling and safely transporting a student attempting to commit suicide. My knowledge of each student involved, helped both cases to be solved in a timely and calm manner.

## Events

**April:** I conducted books and badges at Our Lady of Mount Carmel with the assistance of PO Castillo. (We read to each class and handed out souvenirs to each student).

**May:** Village and public schools Books and Badges (Books donated by an organization were given out to all participants).

Soccer balls were given out to soccer academy participants for the younger class

**June:** Soccer balls distributed to older academy participant. SRO participated in Mt. Carmel 8<sup>th</sup> grade pizza party (pizza provided by SRO). SRO participated in Mt Carmel 8<sup>th</sup> graders confirmation preparation (some students needed to perform community service hours; I was able to take those individuals throughout the school to fulfil those hours). SRO participated in Hamilton High School senior graduation as well as Grady and Dixson move up celebration. During the summer months, I filled in numerous patrol tours as needed for vacation coverage.

**August:** Wreaths across America Event

**September:** Participated in Greenburgh youth court, met with coordinators of the program in an attempt to recruit Elmsford students. Applications and explanation of the program was given to the student body president. Schools reopened fully in-person. Schools openings and closings conducted. Walkthroughs of the schools resumed. Bookbags and school supplies were given out at Dixson to every student.

**October:** The Police Community team with the help of the Mayor, conducted Coffee and donut with a Cop during the morning hours, we set up a tent in front of Dunkin Donuts and gave away mugs to the community. During the evening hours we had Coffee and Cake with a cop. Community members that participated received a mug and a tour of the police department. Pumpkins were donated to Dixson and Grady schools for Halloween. Community police unit participated in Elmsford Day (answered questions the community members had and gave out police souvenirs (cups, pencils, booklets). Participated in Village Halloween tent as well as Trunk or Treat events at Mt Carmel and Hamilton Schools.

**November:** Assisted Elmsford School district get food donations for their Thanksgiving food drive.

**December:** Participated in Village Christmas events. Worked the chocolate and cookies tent where I greeted all the community members that participated.

Above are just some of the highlights of 2021, I also performed lockdown drills and evacuation drills at all the schools. I also spoke to classes in numerous law topics as requested by teachers. Conducted child safety classes at Bright Horizon academy. In August, I participated in a

continued education conference. The New York Youth Officers and SRO's Association named me regional representative of region 14 (Westchester/Putnam/Rockland Counties). I was also named Westchester County Youth Officers Association Vice President. We are putting the Village of Elmsford on the map.

Thank you for your continued support and for always guiding the SRO and Community affairs unit in the right direction. For further information feel free to contact me. Looking forward to another busy 2022 as we bring our police department and community closer together.
