Vintage guitarist *Ken Lelen* sings classic American ragtime, jazz and swing tunes and pairs each song with a vintage acoustic guitar for an authentic backin-the-day sound. His concerts are a hit with diverse groups, sundry venues, special clients and niche markets, while his programs offer amusing anecdotes, catchy melodies and clever lyrics about Tin Pan Alley Cats, Juke Joints, Speakeasies, Drugstore Cowboys, Ragtime Rascals, Swing Shift Maisies, Zoot Suiters, Bobby Soxers, Stage Door Johnnies, Jitterbuggers, Radio Ramblers and Folk Song Boomers.

For 23 years he's enthralled audiences at art-&-music centers, churches, house concerts, libraries, museums, retirement villages, senior centers, social clubs and radio — playing 100 concerts a year on the East Coast. Given his affinity for the amiable tunes and beguiling sentiments of the American Songbook, his concerts are renown for acoustic renditions of ragtime, jazz and swing favorites.

Ken Lelen has played steel-stringed acoustic guitar for more than five decades and brings to each concert several of his 20th Century acoustic guitars. Each instrument makes music that is striking for its character, tone and sustain — without the use of electronic gizmos or gimmicks.
